### **K4/K5**

#### **Classroom Supplies:**

**All K-6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students:** All elementary students will be required to purchase a field trip "t-shirt". These shirts will help us keep track of all our precious children whenever the class takes a field trip. T-shirts will cost \$13 each and will be available at Parent Orientation. After purchasing the t-shirt, please write your student's name on the inside tag with a permanent marker. Students will not be permitted to go on a field trip without this t-shirt.

**All K-6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students:** The staff requests that all student Bibles be New International Version. It is very distracting to our students when they are trying to use a variety of versions. Thank you for helping us with this.

**All K-6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students – Art Fee:** All K – 6<sup>th</sup> will be charged a \$25 arts/crafts fee. This fee will simply offset the cost of supplies for all the arts and crafts in the classroom. In this way, parents will not be asked to contribute for art or craft supplies throughout the year. ***The art/craft fee is due at Parents' Orientation.***

**All 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students:** Students in 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade may drink water in their classroom – and on warm days this is important. However, they may only have water in ***clear, plastic water bottles with the snap close top.*** ***Each student should have a water bottle with their name written on it with permanent marker.***

### **3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Grade**

- \***Literature Book Fee:** The 3<sup>rd</sup> -4<sup>th</sup> grade class has a \$15 literature fee to purchase books for the student's participation in literature groups. (Students will mark in these books.)

### **5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> Grade**

- \*Bible (NIV) - a slim line Bible will take less room in your student's backpack
- \*1 – Flash Drive  
(Students will use this to transport computer work from school to home and vice versa.)
- \*16 red ball point pens
- \*16 blue or black ball point pens
- \*25 - #2 pencils
- \*White out tape (no liquid please)
- \*6 dry erase markers (blue or black)
- \*2 packs loose leaf notebook paper
- \*1 – 2” 3-ring binder
- \*Good Quality Compass  
(will cost \$3-\$5)
- \*Good Quality Protractor
- \*100 sheets of graph paper
- \*Personal size antibacterial hand wash  
(waterless)
- \*2 spiral bound notebooks
- \*5 yellow highlighters
- \*2 pocket folder (for homework)
- \***Literature Book Fee:** The 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade class has a \$30 literature fee to purchase books for the student's participation in literature groups. (Students will mark in these books.)

**All 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students:** All 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade students must have an FCS planner/organizer. The teachers have selected an excellent student planner, and they will instruct students about its proper use. The planner will also enable teachers to communicate daily with parents about homework. *Planners will be available at Parents' Orientation. The planners will cost \$9 each.*

**All K-6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students - Incentives Fee:** Each K-6<sup>th</sup> Grade teacher maintains an incentives program – prizes rewarding achievement. If you would like for your student to receive these incentives, a fee of \$15 is due at Parent Orientation. *If parents do not pay the fee, the classroom teacher will communicate the student's achievements to the parent so the parent can reward their student at home.*

**The Following Items Are NOT Allowed To Be Used At FCS:** Any kind of gel pens, any kind of colored pens (except red), any colored paper (only white is permissible), no spiral bound or perforated spiral bound notebooks for homework (teachers may, however, request a spiral bound notebook for journaling purposes only). All homework must be completed on loose leaf notebook paper. Liquid white out is not permitted – only white out tape.

**All 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students Sports Fees:**

In order to rent gymnasiums and fields, pay referees and league fees, all students athletes will be charged a sports fee. Fees are as follows:

1 sport: \$85

2 or more sports: \$160

3 shifts per athlete in gift wrapping booth or \$50 per athlete

**All 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students P.E. Classes:**

\*5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade students will participate in middle school P.E. All P.E. students must purchase a uniform for class. Students who do not “dress down” will receive a deduction in their P.E. grade. Uniforms will be available at Parents' Orientation. The cost of the t-shirt will be \$16. The cost of the NBA length shorts will be \$25. If a student chooses to purchase sweat pants, they will cost \$21 per pair.

**All 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students:**

Netbooks are strongly recommended for all 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students since the majority of their assignments are digital (with pencil/paper alternative assignments). 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade is an introductory middle school and thus students will be given the option to do a variety of digital assignments in preparation for 7<sup>th</sup> grade. These assignments would require students to have their own computer. As always, there will be pencil and paper alternatives, but students usually prefer the digital assignments. The following is the information shared with parents of 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students:

***NETBOOK:*** *The school strongly recommends that each 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade student has a netbook. While every classroom assignment has a paper and pencil equivalent, students typically prefer the project-based assignments that require a computer. In addition, we suggest the battery life of the computer be examined*

*before purchasing it. We recommend a netbook instead of a laptop because most netbooks do not consume battery life as quickly as laptops – and students do not have access to electrical outlets for their computers during the school day.
